Combining the gentle insight of Tom Kite's *A Fairway to Heaven* (which recalls Kite's golf education under Harvey Penick) with the sage perspective of Penick's own *Little Red Book*, Vasquez's tribute is funny, poignant, and full of advice for golfers of all levels.**
