Welcome to the proceedings of ICCHP 2008. We were proud to welcome participants from more than 40 countries from all continents to ICCHP. The International Programme Committee, encompassing 102 experts from all over the world, selected 150 full and 40 short papers out of 360 abstracts submitted to ICCHP. Our acceptance rate of about half of the submissions, demonstrates the scientific quality of the programme and in particular the proceedings you have in your hands. An impressive group of experts agreed to organize "Special Thematic Sessions" (STS) for ICCHP 2008. The existence of these STS sessions helped to bring the meeting into sharper focus in several key areas of assistive technology. In turn, this deeper level of focus helped to bring together the state-of-the-art and mainstream technical, social, cultural and political developments. Our keynote speaker, Jim Fruchterman from BeneTech, USA highlighted the importance of giving access to ICT and AT at a global level. In another keynote by Harold Thimbleby, Swansea University, UK, the role of user-centred design and usability engineering in assistive technology and accessibility was addressed. And finally, a combination keynote and panel discussion was reserved for WAI/WCAG2.0, which we expect to be the new reference point for Web accessibility from the summer of 2008 and beyond.

The purpose of this study was to determine if the effects of Jolly Phonics on letter sounds in kindergarten students. The study was conducted over a nine week period in the fall trimester of the 2011-2012 school year at Tilford Elementary School in Vinton, Iowa. The subjects included the seventeen students in the researcher's kindergarten class. The treatment the subjects received for the nine weeks was in a fifteen minute whole group reading time that consisted of singing lyrics and doing actions for the letter sound. A fifteen minute small group reading time was also done during the Daily Five center time to implement using the letter sounds and recognizing the letter symbols. The DIBELS Next Letter Naming Fluency assessment was used as the pretest and posttest to measure mastery of the letter sounds from the beginning to the end of the study. The Easy CBM assessment was used to monitor the subjects' weekly progress. A teacher anecdotal journal was kept to record observations of the subjects' progress throughout the study. The researcher was able to use the notes to track absenteeism, attitudes of the subjects, and needs of the subjects as they progressed. The results of the study show most of the subjects have growth with the Jolly Phonics program. In conclusion, the researcher would recommend and use the Jolly Phonics program again.
